 - Men Team Championship
 - Women Team Championship
 - Men Singles
 - Women Singles
 - Men Doubles
 - Women Doubles
 - Men Veteran (50 years and above)
- A copy of the updated rules for All India Civil Services Tournaments indicating eligibility criteria, composition of Team, Rules of games etc. has already been circulated to all concerned. The same is available on the website at <http://dopt.gov.in/about-us/wings-or-division-in-dopt/Welfare-divisions→Sports→Recent/General Circulars→All India Civil Service Tournament>.
- The States/UTs and Regional Sports Boards are requested to consider sending their team for the above All India Civil Services Carrom Tournament. The entries may be sent in the prescribed Proforma (attached at annexure) directly to the contact officer/organizer indicated at Para 16 with a copy endorse to CCSCSB on or before **09th March 2020**. Please ensure that the entries are submitted within prescribed time limits.
- List of players along with photocopy of their Identity Card should be authenticated by the authorized officer under his signature & seal.
- All the participants shall carry individual Identity Card/Identity Slip/Age proof for verification of eligibility criteria by the Organizing Committee/Representatives of the Board at the venue of the All India Civil Services Tournaments.
- Addresses, Telephone Numbers, E-mail Addresses may be indicated by the participating State/UTs/RSBs.

8. Managers' meeting may be held on the evening of a day before the date of commencement of the tournament.
9. Every participating team may bring two Flags representing their State/UT/Regional Sport Board with them.
10. It should be ensured that every member of the team report at the venue and participates in the tournament as scheduled. Failure to do so shall be treated as an act of indiscipline. All the participants shall maintain strict discipline on and off the venue of the tournament. Any act of indiscipline/misbehaviour/misconduct will attract the provision of CCS (Conduct) Rules since Government Employees are treated 'ON DUTY' during All India Civil Services Tournaments.
11. The following categories of employees are not eligible for participation in AICS Tournaments:-
- Uniform personnel in Defence Services/Para Military Organisations/Central Police Organisation/Police/RPF/CISF/BSF/ITBP/NSG etc.
 - Employees of Autonomous bodies/undertaking/Public Sector Banks Even though administratively controlled by the Central Ministries.
 - Casual / Daily wages workers.
 - Employees attached to offices on temporary duty.
 - A newly recruited employee who has put less than 6 months in regular establishment/services.
12. Any information regarding change in dates/venue/cancellation etc. about the AICS tournament will be available at <https://dopt.gov.in/about-us/wings-or-division-in-dopt/welfare-divisions>. All the participant teams are, therefore requested to check from organizers of the tournament about any possible change before starting their journey.
13. It is further clarified that matches for 3rd place (both in Team and Individual event) must be organized in order to determine 3rd place.
14. The decision of Referee/Umpires shall be final and binding on the competing teams.
15. Participants are requested to make their own arrangement of accommodation and transport facilities.
