4. The following categories of employees are not eligible for participation in CCSCSB Online Carrom Challenge 2020:-

a. Uniform personnel in Defence Services/Para Military Organisations/Central Police Organisation/Police/RPF/CISF/BSF/ITBP/NSG etc.

- b. Employees of Autonomous bodies/undertaking/Public Sector Banks even though administratively controlled by the Central Ministries.
 - c. Casual/Daily wages workers.
 - d. Employees attached to offices on temporary duty.
 - e. A newly recruited employed who has put less than 6 months in regular establishment/services.
5. Any information regarding change in dates/venue/cancellation etc about the CCSCSB Online Carrom Challenge 2020 will be available on www.dopt.gov.in-notifications-O.M. & Orders-Sports-AICS.
6. The decision of Technical Committee shall be final and binding on the competing participants.
7. Participants should have AICF approved Carrom Board, Carrommen Set, Lamp shed, Striker of their own. They also have their own Facebook profile and necessary equipment such as Mobile/Camera and internet connection for live performance.
8. A cash prize of Rs.5100/- to the winner and Rs.3100/- to the runner in both Men and Women category and Rs.500/- on each white slam shall be given.
9. No govt servant participating in this event shall claim special casual leave/ increment for this event.

Players Ranked 1 will play with Ranked 8, 2 with 7, 3 with 6, 4 with 5 in the Quarter Finals. The Winner of 1st QF will play with Winner of 4th QF & Winner of 2nd QF will play with Winner of 3rd QF in SEMI - FINALS.</p> <p>Winner of both Semi Finals will enter into FINAL. Winner and Runner of Finals will be ranked 1 & 2 of the Challenge respectively.</p>
2.	LIVE PERFORMANCE		
	2.1	CAMERA POSITION	Camera to be fixed in front of the player in such a position that complete board is visible during live performance.
	2.2	ADDITIONAL SET OF CARROMMEN	An additional set of CM is required to keep the chance lost indicator in the form of CM of the same colour for which turn is lost on the left or right frame of the Carrom Board. It is suggested to use the opposite side of the frame on which shade is attached.
	2.3	TOTAL CHANCES LOST IN A BOARD	After each board the player is required to place a slip in Bold and big font mentioning the total number of chances missed in

			<p>that Board facing camera on the frame opposite side of the player and this slip will be remained there during entire performance.</p> <p>Total 8 slips in order Board No. 1 to 8 should be placed in such a manner that it should be clearly visible to viewers.</p>
	2.4	WHITE BACKGROUND ON FRAME	For better visibility all the players are required to place a white sheet on the frame for keeping CM as indicator of missed chances.
	2.5	PLACEMENT OF MISSED CHANCES CM	Missed chance CM shall be placed on the white background only and in the order of missing starting from player's side to upward side of the frame.
3.		FORMAT TO BE FOLLOWED	
	3.1	NO OF BOARDS	PERFORMANCE TO BE SHOWN IN 8 BOARDS
	3.2	TURN OF PLAY	<p>Player A (White) & Player B (Black) turn for both Player A and Player B will be performed by a single player from the same side.</p> <p>A player will start the board and play until the turn is over as per Laws of Carrom, a white CM to be kept on the frame with white background as indicator for one missed chance as player A and start playing as player B from the same side until the turn is over as per Laws of Carrom a black CM to be kept on the frame with white background as indicator for one missed chance as player B and switch over to player A and so on till all the Carrommen are pocketed.</p> <p><i>Every missed chance one debit point in the account of the player.</i></p>
	3.3	QUEEN	<p>Queen has to be covered as per Laws of Carrom either with white or black.</p> <p>However, last Carrommen of White or Black cannot be pocketed until queen is on the board. In case while playing as player A the last white CM has been pocketed while queen is on the board, the white carrommen so pocket alongwith additional white Carrommen to be placed as foul and the chance for white is lost. Same in case of Player B.</p>
	3.4	DUE & DOUBLE DUE	If Single due happened, one c/m will put within outer circle opposite of the player & 1 missing chance will count. In double due, 2 c/m will put within outer circle opposite of the player & chance continue. No missing will count.

	3.5	IN CASE OF TIE	In case of Tie decision will be taken on the basis of Slams scored by Players. If no slam is scored, then progressive score of the player will be noticed.

	4.1	WHITE SLAM	<i>For every White Slam 5 credit points in account of the player</i>
	4.2	BLACK SLAM	<i>For every Black Slam 3 credit points in the account of the player.</i>
	4.3	ULTIMATE SLAM	<i>For every Ultimate Slam 10 credit points in the account of the player.</i>
	4.4	ULTIMATE SLAM DEFINITION	When a player after break performs a white slam and thereafter also black slam without a single miss in that board it will be called as Ultimate Slam.
	4.5	COUNTING OF MISSED CHANCES	After every board the missed chance will be counted by the player and a slip to be placed as per directions at points 2.3. The player will place the slips as per directions at point 2.3 before removing the CM kept on the frame of the board on white background.
5.		REPORTING OF SCORES	
	5.1	FORMAT OF REPORTING OF SCORES BY THE PLAYER	After 8 boards the player is required to report the points of each board in order of board no. 1 to 8. 9+7+5+8+0+11+1+2 = 43 debit points 10+5+3 = 18 credit points Ultimate Slam board no. 5 White Slam board no.7 Black Slam board no. 8 Final score. 43-18=25 points
	5.2.	WHEN & WHERE TO REPORT	The reporting should be done within 15 minutes after completion of the 8 th Board in the comments section of player's video for that match. It shall also be reported to WhatsApp group of the players. WhatsApp group will be created after the last date of receipt of entry.
6.	6.1	DISRUPTION DURING LIVE PERFORMANCE	Every complete board's live performance will be taken into account. In case of disruption due to any reason that board will be replayed.

	6.2	LONG BREAK DURING LIVE PERFORMANCE	The long break of more than 15 minutes shall be reported to the Technical Team on Whatsapp group with reason.
7.	7.1	QUERY OR OBSERVATION	A query or observation by any player shall be submitted latest by 10 am on the following day of the performance on WhatsApp group only. Query or observation submitted on fb group shall not be considered
	7.2	LATE SUBMISSION OF QUERY OR OBSERVATION	Query or observation submitted specified time in point 7 above shall not be considered under any circumstances.
	7.3	DECISION ON QUERY OR OBSERVATION	Decision of Technical Committee whether covered in these rules or not shall be final and binding.
