
Please refer to O.M. No. 5/15/2024-Welfare dated 24.02.2026 issued by the Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT), wherein the recognition of the Central Secretariat Club has been withdrawn.

2. It has, however, been observed that the Central Secretariat Club had issued circulars seeking membership of the Club under your name/signature, which have also been uploaded on the Club's website (<https://www.csclub.in/>), mentioning that "the Central Secretariat Club (CSC) is working under the aegis of the Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT)..."

In view of the derecognition of the Central Secretariat Club by DoPT, the Club is hereby directed to immediately disassociate the name of DoPT from all its circulars/letters/notices, etc., available on the Club's website and other platforms. A corrigendum to this effect may also be issued. The above action must be completed within three (3) days from the date of issuance of this letter.
