The Department of Personnel & Training is considering to amend the CSS Assistants' Grade (Direct Recruit Competitive Examination) Regulations, 2010 to increase the upper age limit for direct recruit Assistants from the present 27 years to 30 years and also to remove the restriction on number of attempts in the competitive examination held by Staff Selection Commission for direct recruitment to the grade.

G.S.R. (E).– In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in pursuance of clauses (a) and (c) of sub-rule (2) of rule 12 of the Central Secretariat Service Rules, 2009, the President hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Central Secretariat Service Assistants' Grade (Direct Recruit Competitive Examination) Regulations, 2010, namely :–

1. Short title and commencement.– (1) These regulations may be called the Central Secretariat Service Assistants' Grade (Direct Recruit Competitive Examination) Amendment Regulations, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Secretariat Service Assistants' Grade (Direct Recruit Competitive Examination) Regulations, 2010, in regulation 4, –

(a) in clause (ii), for the words and figures 'age of 27 years', the words and figures 'age of 30 years' shall be substituted;

(b) the clause (iv) shall be omitted.
