# Information sought:-

The applicant in his RTI spread over 4 pages containing 19 queries has sought information related to the delivery details of various speed-post and the details of the person to whom the same were handed over.

#### **Grounds for the Second Appeal:**

The CPIO has not provided the desired information.

### Relevant Facts emerging during Hearing:

The following were present

Appellant: Mr. Dharampal through TC M: 9992250525

Respondent: Mr. R C Meena CPIO

The appellant pleaded that the respondents have denied information on the ground that he has asked for too much information. He further submitted that the respondents have not fully complied with the Commission's earlier directions to review his RTI applications/appeals and provide him the information. The CPIO pleaded that the information sought by the appellant has become time barred and the relevant records have been weeded out in cleanliness drive under taken in July 2014. The appellant pleaded that some compensation should be awarded for the detriment caused to him due to non provision of information.

### **Decision notice:**

The CPIO has submitted that the relevant records have been weeded out.

The appellant has not been provided information. For the detriment caused he deserves to be compensated, therefore in exercise of the powers vested in the CIC under section 19(8)(b) of the RTI Act, we direct the department to compensate him by an amount of Rs.1000/- for the inconvenience and detriment caused to him. Accordingly, the CPIO should ensure that this amount is remitted to the appellant by demand draft/pay order within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
