Parties Present:

The appellant is present for video conference at NIC centre, Sultanpur. The Public Authority is represented by M.P.Singh.

FACTS:

2. Appellant through his RTI application sought for copy of speech delivered on Law Day since 1950, details of salary, movable immovable property etc of Judges throughout India etc. PIO replied that information is not held by them. Being unsatisfied with PIO reply, the appellant made First Appeal. First Appellate Authority rejected the appeal by stating that there is no merit in the matter. Unsatisfied with FAA order, appellant approached the Commission through this present second appeal.

Proceedings Before the Commission:

3. Both the parties made their submissions. The Commission having heard the submissions and perused the record, observes that the information sought by the appellant is from the year 1952 to 2015 that is for 63 years which is very unreasonable as the same is very voluminous. The appellant who is making submissions through video conference, could not convince the Commission why he needs this huge information. The Commission, therefore, does not interfere with the FAA order and **dismisses** the appeal.
