Appeal received after 7 days of issue of this notice will not be considered. **However, the candidates are advised to file the appeal, if they so desire, as early as possible so that their re-medical examination may be held at an early date and service allocation could be completed prior to the commencement of Foundation Course.**

3. It is made clear that the Appellate Medical Board would conduct the medical examination only if your appeal has been received in the office within the stipulated time.

4. The medical examination by the Appellate Medical Board will be at your own cost. There is to say if any amount is to be paid to the Hospital in connection with your medical examination, the same shall be paid by you direct to the Hospital.

5. Please note that the findings of the Appellate Medical Board will be final.
