
2. In case declared unfit for technical service/police services/IRTS, the appeal should be preferred within 7 days from the date of this notice failing which it will be

presumed that the candidate(s) is/are not interested in filing the appeal. Appeal received after 7 days of issue of this notice will not be considered. **However, the candidates are advised to file the appeal, if they so desire, as early as possible so that their re-medical examination may be held at an early date and service allocation could be completed prior to the commencement of Foundation Course.**

3. In case of candidate declared temporary unfit i.e. Nishant Agarwal (Roll No. 2885), he has to get himself medically fit and complete his medical examination within the six months of uploading of this notice on this Department's website as per CSE Rules-2015. The candidate has to submit medical fitness certificate to this Department and on the basis of that his medical examination will be scheduled only within the above mentioned six months period. Further, the candidate was declared unfit for technical services due to substandard height earlier and the candidate did not appeal against the findings of CSMB, therefore, he will not be provided chance for appeal for this reason again.

4. It is made clear that the Appellate Medical Board would conduct the medical examination only if your appeal has been received in the office within the stipulated time.
