Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware, consequent upon enactment of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) on 15th June, 2005, by the Government of India, the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 4, sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 5, Sections 12,13,15,16,24,27 and 28 of the Act came into force with immediate effect. The remaining provisions of the said Act came into force on 12th October, 2005. Thereafter, the Right to Information Rules, 2005, under the said Act were notified by the Central Government on the 16th September, 2005. Subsequently, these Rules have been replaced by the Central Government by notifying the Right to Information Rules, 2012, on 31st July, 2012. Since notification of the said Act and the Rules, execution instructions and guidelines have been issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India, from time to time, for smooth implementation of the said Act and the Rules. Separately, directions were issued by the Central Information Commission (CIC) to public authorities on 15th November, 2010, under the provisions of Section 19 (8) (a) of the aforesaid Act and, later, the instructions for transparency audit of the suo motu disclosures under Section 4 of the Act were issued by the Commission to the various public authorities.

With a view to ensuring smooth implementation of the aforesaid Act and the Rules framed thereunder, as also the various instructions and guidelines, issued by the DoPT as well as the CIC on the subject, the Institute of Public Administration (IPA) is conducting its 49th two day functional workshop on June 11 & 12, 2019, as mentioned above.
