

Sub: Important information regarding Medical Examination of recommended candidates of CSE-2013 (Main List) & CSE-2012 (Reserve List):

1. Candidates recommended by UPSC for service allocation on the basis of Civil Services Examination (CSE)-2013 (Main List) and CSE 2012 (Reserve List) are advised to visit regularly DOPT's website (www.persmin.nic.in) for updates regarding medical examination status etc. for information and immediate action by the recommended candidates.
2. All candidates recommended by UPSC for service allocation on the basis of CSE 2013 (Main List) and CSE 2012 (Reserve List) who have not got their medical examination completed so far are required to get in touch with the concerned hospitals, where they were medically examined and get their medical examination completed immediately without any further delay. In case of any difficulty in this regard, the candidates may also contact AIS-I Section in DOPT (Telephone No. 2309 3683).
3. Medical reports received from the hospitals are being scrutinized and wherever required, under rules, opportunity is being given to candidates for making an appeal against the findings of the Medical Board. A candidate, who is to be given an opportunity to file an appeal, may ascertain the status of the findings of medical examination which is being intimated to him/her in his/her e-mail id as well as through speed post.
4. All the candidates who are given opportunity to file appeal against the findings of the medical report may prefer an appeal before this Department immediately as per procedure for timely completion of their medical examination by the Appellate Medical Board. An intimation of such appeal may also be sent through e-mail to this Department at uss2@nic.in for advance action.
5. It may be noted that such candidates whose medical examination report is not finalized in time, service allocation in their case will be delayed consequent upon which they will not be nominated for Foundation Course this year along with others.
