

Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 06/10/2015 to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines

A meeting was held on 06/10/2015 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines. The members of the committee EO & AS and AS(S&V) were also present.

The Committee took note of the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 30/09/2015.

The Committee thereafter took the fresh cases and after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case, took following decisions in the meeting:-

Case 1: Inter cadre transfer of Shri Rahul Hooda, IAS (HP:15) from Himachal Pradesh cadre to Haryana cadre on grounds of marriage with Ms Manisha Choudhary, IPS (HR:2011)

The Committee was informed that the home state of Shri Rahul Hooda, IAS (HP:15) is Delhi as per Cadre allocation (CSE-2014). The officer has requested for cadre transfer on grounds of marriage with Ms Manisha Choudhary, IPS (HR:2011). The committee directed to seek comments of the concerned State Governments and vigilance status of the officer. Thereafter, the proposal may be put up for the approval of Secretary (P) through EO & AS on receipt of no objection/consent from the State Governments.

Case 2: Inter cadre deputation of Shri Priyatu Mandal, IAS (HP:2006) from Himachal Pradesh cadre to West Bengal cadre.

The Committee was informed that the officer has requested for inter cadre deputation to West Bengal, his home state due to the health condition of both his parents. The State Government of Himachal Pradesh vide letter dated 17/09/2015 has conveyed no objection to spare the services of the officer to serve on inter cadre deputation to West Bengal. It was further informed by State Government of Himachal Pradesh vide letter dated 19/09/2015 that the officer has completed nine years of service in the cadre on 29/08/2015.

The Committee directed to seek comments of State Government of West Bengal and vigilance status of the officer. Thereafter, the proposal along with ACC note may be put up for consideration and approval of ACC.
