

Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 15.06.2016 to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines.

A meeting was held on 15.06.2016 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre deputation period requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines. The members of the committee EO & AS and AS(S&V) were also present. Further, US (S-III) was also present to assist the Committee in the meeting.

The Committee took note of the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 31.05.2016. The Committee after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case took following decisions in the meeting:-

Case 1: Inter cadre deputation of Shri K.S.Raj, IAS (PB:2011) from Punjab cadre to Uttar Pradesh cadre

The Committee was informed that the officer being an IAS of batch 2011 has not completed the required service of nine years in the cadre. **The Committee after detailed deliberations decided not to recommend the proposal of the officer as is not covered under the extant guidelines.**

Case 2: Request for extension of deputation of Ms. A. Mona Sreenivas, IAS (HY:06) cadre to AGMUT cadre for a further period of one year beyond 11.07.2016

The proposal of the officer was earlier placed before the Committee in its meeting held on 25.05.2016 wherein the Committee directed to seek the clarification / reasons in writing from the officer. Now, the officer has conveyed the reasons for extension. **The Committee after detailed deliberations recommended the proposal and directed to seek comments from State Government of Haryana and MHA and vigilance status of the officer. Thereafter, on receipt of requisite comments/consent, the proposal along with ACC note may be put up for the approval of ACC.**

Case 3: Premature repatriation of Dr. Adapa Karthik, IAS (PB:2008) from AGMUT (Chandigarh Administration) to Punjab cadre

The Committee was informed that the Ministry of Home Affairs has requested for premature repatriation of Dr. Adapa Karthik, IAS (PB:2008) from AGMUT (Chandigarh Administration) to Punjab cadre as the competent authority has granted Ex-India Study leave to Dr. Adapa Karthik, IAS (PB:2008) from 01.08.2016 to 15.07.2018. **The**

Committee after detailed deliberations directed to seek vigilance status of the officer and put up ACC note for premature repatriation of the officer to ACC.

Case 4: Status of PH category officers whose cadre transfer is under process

The proposal of inter-cadre transfer of PH category officers was earlier discussed in the Committee in its meeting held on 17.05.2016 wherein the Committee directed to seek necessary clarification from the concerned State Governments. The Committee was informed that the necessary clarification from Government of Nagaland in respect of Ms. Bhagyashree Banayat, IAS (NL:12) and from Assam Govt. in respect of Shri Pawar Narsing Sambhaji, IAS (AM:13) has been received. However, the same is pending from the State Government of West Bengal and Jharkhand. **The Committee after detailed deliberations recommended the proposal in respect of Shri Pawar Narsing Sambhaji, IAS (AM:13) and Ms. Bhagyashree Banayat, IAS (NL:12) and directed to put up the cases accordingly. Further, the Committee also directed to expedite the comments from State Government of West Bengal and Jharkhand.**

Case 5: Request for extension of deputation of Ms. Gauri Parasher Joshi, IAS (OR:2009) from Odisha cadre to Haryana cadre for a further period of two years beyond April 2017

The Committee was informed that the officer has been conveyed inter cadre deputation for a period of three years vide notification dated 17.04.2014 on personal grounds, in relaxation of the guidelines. The officer has requested for extension of inter cadre deputation for a further period of two years beyond April 2017. **The Committee recommended the proposal and directed to seek comments of State Government of Haryana and Odisha. Thereafter, on receipt of requisite comments/consent, the proposal along with ACC note may be put up for the approval of ACC.**
