Subject: Preparation of the Detailed Demands for Grants (DDG) in UBIS.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Para 15.6 of the Budget Circular 2022-23, where in it was mentioned that entry of Detailed Demands for Grants by the Ministries/Department in the UBIS shall be mandatory so that DDG generated from UBIS would feed into PFMS to permit expenditure to take place from **2022-23**. It was also mentioned that the Ministries/Departments shall ensure that their SBEs and their DDGs are congruent to each other and the figures shown in SBE and the figures reflected in DDG tally.

2. In view of the above, all Ministries/Departments are requested to ensure entry of their respective DDGs in UBIS latest by **15.3.2022**.
