**Notification**

**G.S.R. \_\_\_\_ (E).**— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the All India Services Act, 1951 (61 of 1951) and sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 76 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014 (6 of 2014), read with the first proviso to sub-rule (2) of rule 4 of the Indian Forest Service (Cadre) Rules, 1966 and the Indian Forest Service (Fixation of Cadre Strength) Regulations, 1966, the Central Government, in consultation with the Government of **Andhra Pradesh**, hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Indian Forest Service (Fixation of Cadre Strength) Regulations, 1966, namely:-

1. (1) These regulations may be called the Indian Forest Service (Fixation of cadre Strength) Amendment Regulations, 2014.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Indian Forest Service (Fixation of Cadre Strength) Regulations, 1966, in the schedule,-
  - (i) for the heading **“Andhra Pradesh”** and the entries occurring thereunder, the following shall be substituted, namely:-


