Office Memorandum

Subject:- Grant of age concession to blind, deaf-mute and orthopaedically handicapped persons for appointment to Gr.'A' & 'B' posts which are not filled through open competitive examination.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that this Department's O.M. No.15012/6/77-Estt(D) dated the 28th January, 1978 (copy enclosed) on the above subject provides that for purpose of appointment to class III and Class-IV (Now Group C and Group D) posts, filled through the Employment Exchanges, the upper age limit in the case of blind, deaf-mute and orthopaedically handicapped persons shall be relaxed upto 10 years.

2. The question whether similar age-relaxation should be granted to the physically handicapped persons for appointment to Group-A & Group-B posts has been considered in consultation with the UPSC and C&AG. It has now been decided to allow age relaxation of 5 years (10 years for SC/ST and 8 years for OBC) to blind, deaf mute and orthopaedically handicapped persons for appointment to Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts/services except where recruitment is made through Open Competitive Examination.
